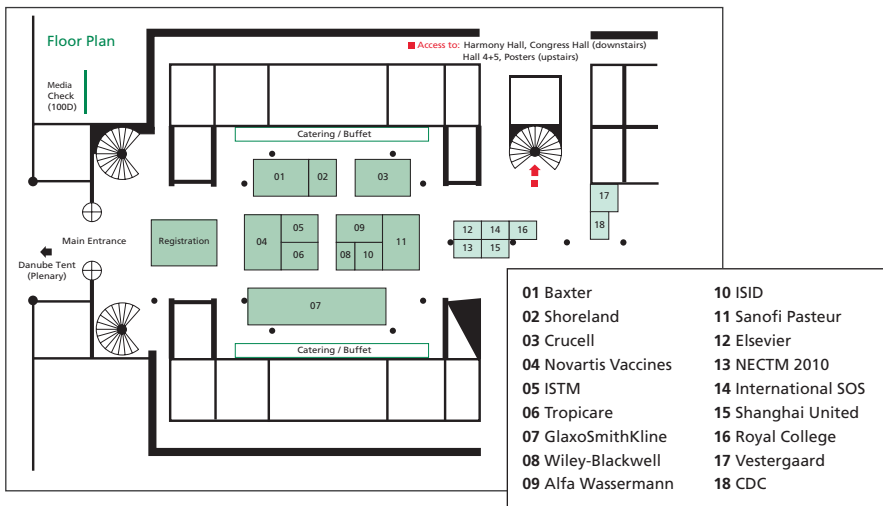


## Floor Plans (Building A)
